About us

The Horse Clinics at Wolica belong to the Warsaw University of Life Sciences-SGGW. They are located in Warsaw (Ursynów District). The centre is a didactic (educational) resort. Currently, 14 horses are kept in the stables. All of them are owned by the University. The Clinics' horses are suitable for recreational rides. Horses are kept in the new well-lit stables. Animals are in the care of Clinics' employees (well educated) and volunteers. Next to the stables there are fenced paddocks, which are also used as a place for horse riding. About 20 hectares of land which is situated below the scarp is used for horse riding in the countryside.

Company history

Centurion is a professional dressage training centre in Poland. It is situated in the Żabia Wola Municipality, about 35 km from Warsaw. Its origins date back to 2004. In 2006 theowners started searching for a suitable site. In August (2006) the company purchased 10 hectares of fenced fields with good soil for pasture and 1000m^2 big hall (which served as a store for fruits and vegetables in the past). In October 2006 the construction of the main building, the stables, hall and social facilities started. At the same time 8 hectares of paddocks for horses were prepared. The horses were introduced to the centre in May 2007. All the facilities were ready for use.
